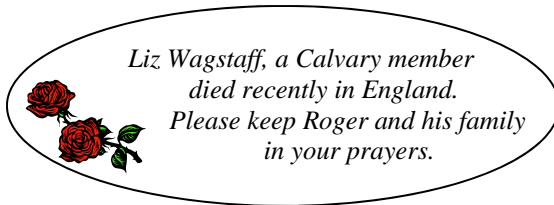


PRAYERS FOR HEALING
