Job Summary

The Nursery Attendant provides care and nurturing for newborns through children 3 1/2 years on Sunday mornings. The Nursery Attendant will foster strong relationships with families, the church and the community.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Care for the physical, emotional and spiritual well-being of children, ages newborn through 3 ½ years on Sunday mornings from 9:15 am to approximately 12:15 pm. 3 hours guaranteed on Sundays.
- Be polite, friendly, and courteous to all children, parents/guardians, and volunteers.
- Must be able to work with various types of people and be punctual, flexible, cooperative, and friendly.
- Maintain good health, safety, and sanitary procedures in the nursery.
- Ability to adapt and interact with a variety of personalities and characteristics common to small children.
- Stay until all children are picked up by their parents or guardians.
- Set up and clean-up the nursery room, including cleaning and disinfecting toys.
- Communicate planned absences with two-week advance notice and unplanned absences as soon as possible.
